- √ well-qualified teachers and aides (with a specialization in early childhood education and child development)
- √ teacher and assistant professional development opportunities
- ✓ parents involved in the classroom
- ✓ positive and supportive teacher-child interactions
- ✓ stimulating activities and instructional materials in the classroom
- √ quality instruction in a wide range of subjects, including art, music, science, math, problem-solving, language development, and reasoning
