The Role:

Essential Functions of This Position

- Embrace the opportunity to help students view their learning as an act of worship and an opportunity to develop their unique gifts for the glory of God and the good of others.
- Encourage students to develop a deeper understanding of God through the lens of the learning specific to the subject.
- Embrace the school's core instructional ideas and strategies, while bringing personal creativity and style to instruction.
- Teach students using the approved approach and instructional materials, using a range of assessment strategies to improve learning for each individual student.
- Participate in staff meetings, professional growth, and other meetings
- Promote a caring, loving, and safe learning environment, including maintaining order in the classroom through clear routines and a welcoming, hospitable space.
- Maintain a growth mindset, pursuing improvement both at the personal level and across the organization.
- Partner lovingly and patiently with parents, caregivers, and other adults who help provide influence in students' lives.
- Use technology wisely and effectively as a tool to improve learning.
- Participate in special projects as assigned and perform related duties and key responsibilities consistent with the scope and intent of the position.
- The expectation for ECS Middle School teachers is that they will teach five sections in our schedule of seven classes. These five sections typically include two "core" classes and an elective.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree (required), Master's degree (preferred), or Doctorate from an accredited university or college, in education or a related field.
- Successful teaching experience and effective work with middle school age students, preferably in a Christian independent school setting.
- Valid/Current WA State Teaching Certificate with appropriate endorsements or equivalent demonstrated experience (certification from another state is acceptable)
- Valid/Current First Aid and CPR Certification (provided)
- Clearance from Criminal Justice fingerprint/Background Clearance
